### The Essentials of Disciplining Children

Many of today's parents are asking themselves questions such as, "How can I control my children?" "How do I discipline my children?" "How do I make my children mind me?" I have seen it many times, and so have you. Self willed children running, playing, etc. without regard to what a parent is them. They just keep running, fussing, shouting, hitting, kicking, until the parent makes a move toward them. Then, at times, I've seen the child begin running from their parent, as if they are playing a game.

Discipline of children is no game. It's serious business. Proper discipline will save a child from a life of serious problems...behavioral problems at school, at the work place, troubles with the law, prison time, and even can save one from death. How many parents have seen their son or daughter ignore their command to "stop," when they're chasing a ball which has rolled into the street, not paying attention to the car that strikes them. Those parents have wished a million they would've trained their child to obey their command upon first call. The Bible says, "*Train up a child...*" (Prov. 22:6) Discipline for a child is training the child to respond immediately to what their caregivers tell them. First care givers are parents. If a child is taught to respond to their parents words, directions, commands, etc. then that child will already be trained on how to respond to those who are "over" them, be it other relatives, teachers, bosses, policemen, government, etc.
