“The Lord is my portion, saith my soul” (Lam.3:24)

Rev. and Mrs. Bill Harvey to Mexico

We thank the Lord for His blessings during August in the churches in Mexico. The attendance average for this period was 3,306 with 464 saved. There were 68 baptized. In the new mission in Reynosa, our high attendance has been 44. Ten adults have been saved and 22 children since we started 3 months ago. I baptized two adult men during August. We also received a mission offering of 1,440 dollars last month and this was given to the Bible Institute in Mante.

In August, we traveled to Zacatecas for the organization of the Bethel Baptist Church. This work was started by and maintained by graduates from our school. We received enough help from a church in the states to buy land and build part of the building. We had four pastors from Monterrey, two from Mante, and another from Guadalajara to come help our with the organization of the church. Their attendance average is about 45 and souls are saved on a regular basis.

We have attended the opening day of school in the Bible Institute in Mante since 1959. We were happy to be present for this year’s opening also. There were 17 new students present and other have sent in applications that didn’t show up on opening day. We believe some of them will enroll in the next few days. On Monday night our new auditorium was nearly filled to capacity with people from the nearby churches. Quite a few former students brought sons and daughters to be enrolled. We are thankful that those who have studied are ready to recommend the school to their children. Pray with us that we have a good year.
